

## Dr. Joachim Breuer

**Director General, German Social Accident Insurance (DGUV)  
Chairman of the Technical Commission on Accident Insurance (ISSA)  
Vice President Europe of Rehabilitation International (RI)**

Dr. Joachim Breuer studied law at the Universities of Bonn and Berlin, Germany. He obtained his degree in 1984 and became a doctor of law in 1985.

After working for the German Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry for five years, he joined the Federation of German Accident Insurance Institutions (HVBG) in St. Augustin, Germany.

In 1995 he became Director General of the accident insurance and prevention institution for the German mining industry.

In 2002, Dr. Breuer returned to HVBG (now DGUV)\*, the umbrella organization of all German accident insurance funds in the industrial sector, this time as Director General.
